**NOTE: These are non-voting positions.**

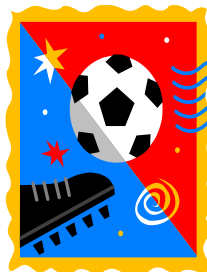
You can help by becoming an “**extension**” of the board. Throughout the year, there are many areas that we could really use your assistance. Here are some areas that we are looking to fill:

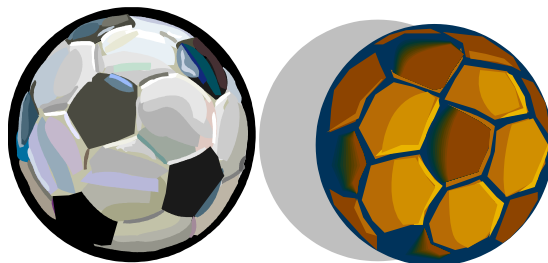
We want to thank everyone who helped make this a success. The coaches and trainers who worked with the kids made a big impression on everyone, including players and parents who all had a great weekend.

As many of you know by now, referees are those individuals who are willing to help out where they can. Sure, they are paid, but that did not help this year in attracting more people to help in this area.

We started the year on a very good note by having almost 50 individuals sign-up for the referee class. This class is held on two nights a week for three weeks. The classes were held at the Marina Community Center. The dates were Tuesday and Thursday and lasting 3 hours each day, for 3 weeks, for a total of 18 hours.

To the disappointment of the league, only 7 individuals showed up.

The board is looking into other means of attracting individuals to help in covering games for next year.

- There may be requirements for teams to have referees registered on their teams in order to cover games, other then their own.
- Increase the pay scale to retain referees.
- Prior to any coach being approved to coach a team, he or she submit at least two individuals who would sign up for the referee class.

These are just some of the ideas. If you have any other thoughts, give Keith a call or email him and give him your thoughts. At this point, we need your input on how to get more people to help with the referee program.
